

Executive order on repayment rates and fees for inspection and monitoring of certain games

The following is stipulated pursuant to Article 41, Article 42(6) and Article 60 of Act No 848 of 1 July 2010 on gaming:

Chapter 1

Danske Spil A/S

Article 1. Of the total stakes in lotteries and betting on horses and dogs offered by Danske Spil A/S, cf. Articles 6 and 12 of the Act, a minimum of 45% shall be used for prizes.

Chapter 2

Det Danske Klasselotteri A/S

Article 2. Of the total stakes in state lotteries offered by Det Danske Klasselotteri A/S, cf. Article 8 of the Act, at least 65% and no more than 72% must be used for prizes.

Chapter 3

Local pools betting

Article 3. For pools betting in connection with dog racing at a betting track, pigeon racing and horse racing, the following shares of the stakes must be used for the payment of winnings to the players:

- 1) 80% for winner and place bets.
- 2) At least 65% for combination betting except for V5 and V6 games.
- 3) 59% for V5 and V6 games.

2. For pools betting in connection with bicycle racing on a track, at least the following proportions must be used to pay winnings to the players:

- 1) 65% for winner and place bets.
- 2) 60% for other bets.

3. The remainder of the stakes shall accrue to the licence-holder, after the deduction of the fee for the exchequer.

4. In connection with the payment of winnings to the players, the calculated winnings shall be rounded down to whole kroner amounts to gain full kroner so that the excess øre shall accrue to the licence-holder.

Chapter 4

Fees for the supervision of Danske Spil A/S and Det Danske Klasselotteri A/S

Article 4. Danske Spil A/S and Det Danske Klasselotteri A/S shall pay an annual fee for a calendar year to cover the costs associated with supervision of the companies' provision of gaming and for monitoring the gaming market.

2. The fee shall be paid on account to the state on the first business day in April.

3. The size of the payment on account for a 1-year period shall be fixed by agreement between the licence-holders and the gaming authority. When fixing the size of the payment on account, allowance must be made for the increased or reduced costs during the preceding period.

4. The development costs and other one-time costs that it is not possible to estimate in advance, shall be borne by the gaming authority and charged later to Danske Spil A/S and Det Danske Klasselotteri A/S.

Chapter 5

Sanctions

Article 5. Unless a more severe penalty is warranted under other legislation, a person who intentionally or through gross negligence violates Article 3(1) and (2) shall be punished by a fine.

2. Companies, etc. (legal persons) can be held criminally liable in accordance with the regulations in Chapter 5 of the criminal code.

Chapter 6

Entry into force

Article 6. The executive order shall enter into force on XX.XXXX
