Certification of gambling systems

When a gambling operator applies for a licence to provide online casino and/or betting, the gambling operator's gambling system - i.e., the system used to provide, execute and operate games - must obtain a number of certifications in order for the operator to operate in the Danish market. For each certification, one standard report must be completed. The template for the standard report is available on the Danish Gambling Authority's website. The process for achieving each certification is similar.

Once the gambling operator has obtained a licence, the certifications must be renewed at fixed intervals, repeating the process.

Start

The gambling operator's systems must be certified.



1

The gambling operator contacts an accredited testing company to test and inspect the gambling system.



2

The testing company tests and inspects whether the gambling operator's systems meet the certification requirements. If the gambling operator uses one or more suppliers, the testing company must see documentation that these have been tested and inspected according to Danish requirements. The results are compiled in a standard report.



3

The testing company sends the completed standard report to the gambling operator.



Z

The gambling operator checks the information in the completed standard report.

The gambling operator sends the completed standard report to the Danish Gambling Authority. The Danish Gambling Authority shall only receive one standard report for each of the certifications. This standard report gathers testing and inspection of the gambling operator's system as well as documentation from all suppliers.



6

The Danish Gambling Authority reviews the standard report.



7

If all requirements are met, the gambling operator achieves certification. If there are any requirements that are not met, they must be rectified, and steps 2-7 are repeated. Certification is only valid if all suppliers are included, and all requirements are passed.
